

**LOCKE TOWNSHIP, INGHAM COUNTY, MICHIGAN**  
**RESOLUTION 2024-06 PROPOSAL FOR SENIOR CENTER MILLAGE**  
[Rescinding Resolution 2024-05 WILLIAMSTON AREA SENIOR CENTER MILLAGE PROPOSAL]

**WHEREAS**, the Locke Township Board wishes to provide services to senior citizens who are residents of Locke Township; and

**WHEREAS**, Townships may provide senior services, as authorized by Public Act 39 of 1976, MCL400.571, *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, Townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the Williamston Area Senior Center is willing and able to perform the senior activities and services the Township requires; and

**WHEREAS**, the Locke Township Board wishes to levy .2438 mills (\$0.2438 per \$1000 of taxable value) to provide activities and services to senior citizens.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Locke Township Board, Ingham County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the November 5, 2024 election ballot for Locke Township:

**LOCKE TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL FOR SENIOR CENTER MILLAGE**

**Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Locke Township be levied at .2438 mills (\$0.2438 per \$1000 of taxable value) and levied for four (4) years, 2024 - 2027, inclusive, to support the operational expenses of the Williamston Area Senior Center, raising an estimated \$22,985.20 in the first year of its levy and as provided by law.**
